To the Constables of the Town of Chilmark, GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to warn and notify the inhabitants of the Town of Chilmark, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to vote at the Chilmark Community Center in said Town of Chilmark on **Tuesday, the Nineteenth day of January** in the year of our lord Two thousand and ten from **7 A.M. to 8 P.M.**, there and then to cast their votes in the Special Town Election on the following question:

Question 1. Shall the Town of Chilmark be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issued in order to construct three affordable housing duplex rental buildings at Middle Line Road, and for the payment of any and all other costs incidental and related thereto?

The polls for voting on the Official Ballot will be open at 7 o'clock afore noon, and shall close at eight o'clock in the afternoon.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon at the time and place of the Special Town Election.
