This is to certify that the following Article appeared in the warrant for the Special Town Meeting, on Monday, November 21, 2005 and Question appeared on the ballot for a Special Town Election on Wednesday, December 7, 2005 in Chilmark together with the action taken thereon.

### **Special Town Meeting - November 21, 2005**

**ARTICLE 1.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen under G. L. chapter 40, § 14, to purchase six parcels of land in Menemsha, and the improvements thereon, commonly known as "The Home Port," which property is identified on Assessors Map 27.1 as Parcels 81, 82, 83, 84, 85 and 86, for general municipal purposes, or take any other action relative thereto, and to see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money up to \$3,900,000.00 (Three Million Nine Hundred Thousand and no/100) Dollars, said amount to pay for the purchase of said six parcels of land, and any other services or costs incidental and related thereto; and, further, that to raise the appropriation, the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, is authorized to borrow said sum, or any portion thereof, under and pursuant to Chapter 44 of the General Laws, and to issue bonds and notes of the Town therefor, provided that a majority of the voters casting a ballot thereon at the Special Election to be held on December 7th 2005, vote in the affirmative, to exempt from the provisions of Proposition 2-1/2, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the principal and interest on bonds or notes issued for the Town therefor, provided that a majority of the voters casting a ballot thereon at the Special Election to be held on December 7th 2005, vote in the affirmative, to exempt from the provisions of Proposition 2-1/2, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the principal and interest on bonds or notes issued for the acquisition, or take any other action relative thereto.
