**Monday, September 27, 2010, 7:30 p.m.: Special Town Meeting.**


**Tuesday, September 28, 2010, 5 p.m.:** Last day and hour for Board of Selectmen to notify Town Clerk of referendum question to be on Town Election ballot.

**Tuesday, October 5, 2010:** Last day to send absentee ballots to permanently disabled voters for Town Election.

**Wednesday, October 13, 2010, 2:00-4:00 p.m. & 7:00-8:00 p.m.:** Last day and hours to register to vote and change party enrollment for the local Town Election.

**Tuesday, October 26, 2010:** Last day to post warrant for Town Election.

**Tuesday, November 2, 2010: Town Election.**

The schedule for an override question election on the same day and time as the state election is this:

- 1.) Must pass by majority vote at Special Town Meeting on **Monday, September 27, 2010**
- 2.) Board of Selectmen must vote in a majority to place the question(s), exactly how they will appear, on ballots for November 2, 2010. G.L. c. 59, § 21C(g) and (h)
- 3.) Town Clerk must be notified in writing of the referendum at least 35 days before the election, **Tuesday, September 28, 2010. G.L. c. 54, § 42C**
