Hey Tim

Can the Shellfish Department on the agenda for this Tuesdays meeting.

The Shellfish Committee has has made the fallowing recommendations for the scalloping season.

1. On 11/21/12 Menemsha Pond will be closed in an effort to harvest the remaining adult scallop population in Nashaquitsa.
2. The daily limit will be raised to three struck bushels of scallops on 11/21/12. This is will help remove the remaining population of scallops for Quitsa.
3. Open up the the area outside of Chocker's Creek from the eastern buoy defining the closed area to the west until it meets the town line. Map will be provided at the meeting. This will be effective 11/21/12.
- .4 Reopen Menemsha Pond on 12/3/12 to scalloping for the remainder of the season.
