Dear Mr. Jason,

As we mentioned when we first met with you after the RFP selection process, technology changes may necessitate change-outs or updates to the existing ATC DAS equipment in the Towns of Chilmark and Aquinnah. We're writing you today to let you know that we will need to add an additional electronics box (as already approved in our current grants of location) to accommodate additional carriers. We will also need to swap the existing 8' 2" antenna with a 4' 14" antenna to i) allow for better coverage, ii) support additional carriers, and to iii) accommodate LTE (Long Term Evolution) for new and existing customers.

As noted above, the replacement antenna will be shorter than the current antenna (i.e., 4 feet tall as opposed to 8 feet tall) and the diameter of the new antenna will be approximately the same diameter of the wooden utility pole top and painted to match the pole as closely as possible.

Allowing these changes will increase coverage for each node location and enhance public safety throughout the entire DAS network.

Please note that we plan to start making efforts towards this change out 30 days after the date of this letter. Unless we hear to the contrary, we will deem the proposed DAS enhancement acceptable.

Summary of current changes: Adding customers to the remaining granted locations, antenna swap, and add 2<sup>nd</sup> equipment box.

Future plans: Permitting for new (non-granted) locations for additional coverage in Chilmark and Aquinnah.
