Hi Chuck n' Tim:

Brian Dudley of DEP SERO is enquiring whether we were ever contacted by the University doing the MEP study for Chilmark Pond. They are close to the releasable final. As Brian explains it, each study includes a menu of different scenarios: current state, buildout, etc. One such scenario is reserved for the Town to pick what they want to have as a scenario. For example, some towns may say "we will sewer such-and-such neighborhood", other towns could say "we will kill all the geese in the entire watershed", others might say they will enact zoning restrictions that would impact possible buildout, etc etc.

The multi-million \$\$ question (possibly literally) is: Did the University ever approach the Town to ask which scenario we want them to run? If yes, did we decline to have a "special" scenario included? This would likely have been within the past year or so.

Please let me know, even if the answer is "never heard of this".
