

Ladies & Gentlemen:

In accordance with Chapter 130, section 74A of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Division of Marine Fisheries has reexamined the waters of Tisbury Great Pond (V:31.3). The Division has determined that a portion of Tisbury Great Pond, in the towns of West Tisbury and Chilmark, formerly classified as "PROHIBITED", now meets the criteria for an "APPROVED" classification. As a result of this reclassification, sub-area V:31.3 has been reduced and the official definition of the area has been redefined and the southern portion has been reclassified.

The below-defined area (V:31.0) may be opened to the harvest of shellfish for direct human consumption subject to local rules and regulations under authority of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 130, section 52.




