Dear Mr. Malkin,

Thank you for your letter of November 1st and for your continuing work on this matter for Squibnocket.

We do not support or wish to pursue any alternate or emergency access strategy for Squibnocket Farm from Blacksmith Valley, for the same reason that we do not support a bridge from the beach area: a bridge is not a good approach when there is a better solution which avoids the use of a hard structure. The dune solution will be workable for hundreds of years. It should be recommended before any consideration is given to a bridge in any location.

When and where the utilities to Squibnocket Farm are buried is to be discussed and then accomplished without disturbing the western part of the property. Of course we all want to be part of the process and the discussion. We would not favor any disturbance to the foremost flyway for migratory birds of the Eastern United States.
