

Chilmark Waterways Regulations

Fee and Fine Schedule

Approved by the Board of Selectmen on November 7, 2005

Fees:

- A. Annual Slip Fees:
 - 1. East side of Filled Dock: \$3000
 - 2. Commercial Floating Dock: \$500
 - 3. Small Boat Floating Dock: \$300
 - 4. Channel Dock: \$1500
 - 5. Charter Dock: \$600
 - 6. South East Small Boat Dockage: \$250
- B. Annual Mooring Permit Fee is \$100.
- C. Daily charge for transient dockage for each foot of Length Overall: \$2.50.
Additional daily charge for grandfathered boats after first 14 days: \$10.
Short term Transient Boat fee for each four hours: \$10
- D. Daily transient charge for 30 amp electrical service: \$5.00
- E. Daily transient charge for 50 amp electrical service: \$10.00

Fines by Harbormaster:

- A. First Offense: \$50
- B. Second Offense: \$100
- C. Third Offense: \$200

Important Dates:

January 1st:

Beginning of Mooring year.

January 15th:

Mooring Application and fee must be returned to the Harbormaster by noon to obtain or renew a Mooring.

Slip leases and rent must be returned to Harbormaster by noon to obtain or renew a slip lease.

Letters or emails requesting to be put on or remain on the Slip Waiting List must be sent to the Harbormaster by noon to remain on the Slip Waiting List.

Letters or emails requesting to be put on or remain on the Mooring Waiting List must be sent to the Harbormaster by noon to remain on the Mooring Waiting List.

November 1st: Moorings must be removed from ponds to permit shellfishing.

November 15th:

Harbormaster will send slip leases and Mooring Applications to slip holders and Mooring Permit Holders from the prior year for completion and return with rent or Mooring Application fee.
