Invitation for Bids

The Town of Chilmark is seeking sealed bids for the purchase of one (1) 20,000 gallon water tank as follows: Horizontal FRP tank for buried service; Dome ends; 10' 0" diameter x 32' 6" straight sidewall length; 20,000 gallon capacity; Gel coat exterior; One (1) sidewall seam joint; Sixteen (16) 2" ribs; Six (6) galvanized lifting lugs; One (1) 24" ISO manway w/blind; Two (2) 6" ISO flat face stub flanges; Two (2) blade gussets; One (1) 6" vent gooseneck w/ stainless screen and half coupling; Eight (8) FRP tie down straps; Sixteen (16) cable kits for tie downs; Clear ISO liner; Service Fire Fighting Water; Tank built to ASTM D-3299; Delivery to site. **A complete set of bid documents can be obtained at the Selectmen's Office, Chilmark Town Hall 401 Middle Road; PO Box 119; Chilmark, MA 02535. SEALED BIDS DUE:** Friday, October 8 2010 at 12:00 PM (NOON) at the Selectmen's Office, Chilmark Town Hall 401 Middle Road; PO Box 119; Chilmark, MA 02535. Bids must be marked on their face with "Middle Line Road Water Tank." Bids must include complete non-collusion form, tax compliance certificate and reference form. All bids will be opened at that time and read aloud. **LATE BIDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** The bids must remain firm for forty-five (45) days. The contract will be awarded to the responsive and responsible bidder offering the lowest total price for all items. The contract will be awarded within fifteen (15) days after the bid opening.
