- Discussed an All Island First Responder class in October. Will also include ICS 100 and ICS 700. Deputy Chief Schaeffer and Asst. Chief Rose to put class on. Will work on plan to present to Chief's Association for the training. New class hours is 40 for complete recertification and 24 hours of ConEd every 3 years

Chief Schilling reported the State will not put out a press release on expiring CO2 detectors this time of year.
