

## CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I<br>Name and Title<br>This organization shall be known as the Duken County Fire Chief's Club.

## ARTICLE II <br> Purpose and Object

1. To bring Fire Chicfu and their associates together in conference once a month to discuss ways and means for the betterment, and advancement of the Fire Service.
2. To coordinate the efforts of all engaged in the firld of fite protection to the end that such concerred uction shall gain the confidence of the publle nad scheve steady progress againgt the ravages of fire.

## ARTICLE III <br> Clasuification of Membership

1. Active Members

Chiefs of Fire Departrients, Assibtant Chiefs, and Superintendents of private or Industrial fire departmenta and State Forest shall be ellgible to active memberahip

Any active member in gond standing may, after retirement from active duty, continue to be an active member by conthuing payment of all annual dues and assessmente.
2. Honorary Mernbers

Any person who has rendered conspicuous and ourstanding setvice to the Assoclation or a person who has attained prominence and rendered signal seryice In fire protection and prevention, may be elected to honorary memberahip if previously tecommended for such membership by any active member of Club, and provided further that such person recelves a majority vote from the Association members. Honotary members shall be exempr from the payment of dues and shall have the right to actend meetings of the Association and shall, have the privilege of the foor without the power to vote.

## ARTICLE IV

Power to Vate
Each and every member in good standing shall be entitled to vote. No other member shall be qualified or entitled to vote. The right of an active member to vote shall only be exercised by such member in person. The right to vote may not be dellgated to any person,

Meetlogs
Meetings shall be the third Monday of every month. Place of next meeting to be stated at each meeting, If any change, wilteen notlee by the Secretary.

Oificers

1. The officers of this club shall consist of a President, Vice-President and Secretary-Treasurer, who shall hold office for 1 year,

Due:

3b. Any member ja arreare tor 1 yeat shall automatically be dropped from nembership.

3c. Dropped members may upon payment of the dues that were in arrears plus 3 months duce in advance, be relastated ai members in good atanding.
4. The Secretary-Treasurer shall make a report at the annual meeting in January.
