Open Burn Permit "pre-registration" 2024

Prior to issuance of a burn permit, applicants must preregister with the Fire Chief by completing this form. You must then call on the day you wish to burn to request permission for a permit. Burn permits are ONLY issued on the day you wish to burn. No permits will be issued in advance.

Rules and regulations:

- 1. Burning must be in accordance with Massachusetts regulations 310 CMR DEP 7.07.
- 2. Open burning season is January 15 to May 1.
- 3. You must request a permit each day you wish to burn and you MUST receive verbal permission prior to commencing a burn. *No calls before 8am on Sunday.
- 4. Burning will be allowed to start at 10:00am and must be extinguished by 4pm.
- 5. Burning must be on land proximate to the place of generation, at a location greater than 75' from any dwelling or structure and materials cannot be piled higher than 3 feet, longer than 25 feet, or wider than 10 feet.
- 6. Any open fire must be attended at all times by the permit holder.
- 7. No person shall set, maintain or increase a fire in open air at any time except by permission.
- 8. You must have an appropriate means to extinguish an open air fire completely including; a hose or enough water to extinguish, a rake and shovel.
- 9. Permits may be rescinded at any time.

Under all circumstances burning the following is strictly prohibited:

- 1. brush, trees, cane or driftwood from commercial or industrial land clearing
- 2. grass, hay, leaves, stumps or tires
- 3. construction materials or demolition debris
- 4. household trash
