Dear Abutter:

Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131 Section 40 requires any person filing a Notice of Intent with a conservation commission give notification to abutters.

As such an abutter please note that a Notice of Intent has been filed with the Chilmark Conservation Commission on behalf of the 57 Wequobsque Road Realty Trust to relocate an existing single family dwelling. Due to erosion, the existing house must be moved further inland. The house will be relocated outside of the buffer zone and the existing foundation, and septic system components will be removed and the land restored. The proposed work is located at #57 Wequobsque Road, Chilmark Assessor Parcel 30-116-2.

Copies of this Notice of Intent are on file with the Chilmark Conservation Commission at the Town Hall. For more information or to examine copies contact the Conservation Commission at the Town Hall (508)-645-2114 or this office.

At least 5 days before the public hearing, a legal notice will be published in a local paper.
