On December 6, 2024, the Board of Health presented two items to the Capital Improvement Committee. One of those was a request to add \$75,000 to the Revolving Septic Fund, which, as you explained, doesn't qualify as a capital improvement.

The Board wants to spread this amount over the next five years and requests \$15,000 to be added to the "Septic Repair Grant" line during the next fiscal year. The funding is essential, as it will allow the Health Department to expand the availability of the existing program to provide low-interest loans to our residents to help cover the cost of septic tank design and installation.
