Subject: School Program at Community Center

All – I met with Susan Stevens and Robert Lionette at the Chilmark School this morning. They are planning for a remote learning program in the CCC for 4-5 grades. The program will start on Tuesday, Sept 29, and last thru to the end of October. It will be supervised by the school principal and be staffed by a regular district teacher. It will operate under the school license and not be run by the town. They need to have one or two parents volunteer for the days. It will be open for four hours (nine to one). They would like the town to offer to pay for the special Covid 19 cleaning. They have a custodian substitute signed up to do the cleaning (one half day at regular sub pay). Susan is going to give me an estimated cost for this. I would like us to find this in our budget.

The UIRSD has done a really good job setting up programs for remote learning. The teachers have all been teaching classes on Zoom since last Thursday and all reports are that it is well organized – much better than last spring. But we could help with remote learning centers – at YMCA at Girls and Boys Club, at the West Tisbury School Gym, at CCC. I think we should help by paying out of the Town Budget for cleaning services.
