MIRANDA EDISON; 11 Pitch Pine Lane; AP 21-27: Stabilize an eroding coastal bank on

Vineyard Sound by installing jute netting and planting American Beach Grass Pitch Mapping in a level of the planting.

- 2. 12:40 PM: Site Visit 11/5: PUBLIC HEARING RDA REID SILVA FOR G. CORSON AND CONSTANCE C. ELLIS; 21, 24 Bassett Place Rd.; AP 24-52, 56: Replace and maintain an existing seasonal pier with a fixed pier and seasonal float. Approximately 9.5 sq. ft. of Land Under Salt Ponds and Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage will be disturbed by the support piles.

 2 CHOCKER'S LANE REALTY TRUST; 2 Chocker's Lane; AP 33-4: Renew an expired Order of Conditions (SE 12 621) to install and maintain a walking path with raised walkways over a salt marsh. The walking paths were mowed and a partial Certificate of Compliance was issued for this work. The raised walkways were never installed. Approximately 2 sq. ft. of salt marsh will be disturbed for 24 4X4 walkway support posts.
- 4. Site Visit 11/5: <u>CONTINUED PUBLIC MEETING RDA REID SILVA FOR SHEPHERD'S PATH NOMINEE TRUST</u>; 16 Shepherd's Path; AP 24-1: Install a post and wire fence by hand within the 100-foot buffer zone of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland. The closest activity is approximately 85 feet from the wetland edge.
- 5. Site Visit 11/5: <u>DISCUSS UNPERMITTED CLEARING JAMES MALLOW AND EMILY</u>
 <u>ROSE; 5 Osprey Lane; AP 25-117.3:</u> Possible activity with the ConCom jurisdiction was reported on 10/21. A site visit was made; observed extensive clearing within 100 feet of Chilmark Pond to the water's edge. Work was immediately stopped until further notice.

FOLLOW UP DISCUSSION SE 12 849; CESTAR; 12 Hill Land; AP 32-40: As conditioned before any work is done, review a recommended native species evaluation and revegetation plan for the area where the Phragmites will be flush cut to the ground. This pplan will cover a five year period with a final report at its conclusion.
- 7. EMERGENCY CERTIFICATION GEORGE SOURATI FOR PATRICK COURTNEY; 16 Old Nursery Lane; AP 10-7: The existing domestic water well failed. A request for and an Emergency Certification was issued to install a new well with water line and power trench approximately 41 feet from the wetland edge with appropriate siltation barriers to contain well cuttings.
