The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, acting through the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection ("MassDEP"), entered into an agreement with the Town of Chilmark (the "Grantee"), with an effective date of June 30, 2022, for the purpose of increasing the use and visibility of electric vehicle (EV) infrastructure within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (the "Agreement"). This letter addresses your requested change to the Agreement.

Under the terms of the Agreement, the Grantee is the recipient of funding from the Massachusetts Electric Vehicle Incentive Program ("MassEVIP") Direct Current (DC) Fast Charging program for the purpose of acquiring DC Fast Charging stations, as specified in the Agreement. The Agreement, at Paragraph 1(b), provides that if the Grantee wishes to amend any information in its application, the Grantee must notify MassDEP in writing and receive written approval from MassDEP. Please note that the Agreement, at Paragraph (1)(b), states that any extension requests must be made 7 days prior to the end of the 12 month timeframe listed in the Agreement.

On December 22, 2023, the Grantee notified MassDEP in writing that it needed to extend the project deadline to June 30, 2024.

Pursuant to the Agreement, Paragraph 1(b), MassDEP hereby approves the Grantee's proposed amendment to the Agreement. In all other respects, the Agreement between the parties remains unchanged.
