## **Dukes County ARPA Funding Letter of Inquiry and Suggested Guidelines**

In anticipation of Dukes County receiving Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CLFRF) as established by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) from the U.S. Treasurer, we are accepting Letters of Inquiry from interested organizations. Per current guidance, Eligible Uses for ARPA funds distributed by the County must fall within the following four categories:

- 1. Respond to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19 or its negative economic impacts.
- 2. Provide premium pay to employees providing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency.
- 3. Provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue due to COVID-19.
- 4. Invest in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure.

Letters of Inquiry should indicate which of the four categories you are applying for, be concise, generally one to three pages long, and should be signed by the organization's Executive Director, Manager or Board Chair.

Below is a list of information we are looking for as part of the Letter of Inquiry:

- Filled out Dukes County ARPA/CLFRF Grant Application Cover Sheet
- Brief description of organization and applicability
- Project or Program to be funded
  - Summary one sentence statement of proposed project or program
  - Overview purpose, objectives, goals, how project relates to funder's priorities
  - Description target population, specific action plan, timeframe, and duration
  - Implementation (and results) qualifications for executing proposed project, expected outcomes, how effectiveness will be monitored and evaluated, plan for continuance at conclusion of requested funding
  - Cost amount requested, total project cost, private and public funding sources (pending and received)

Letters of Inquiry must be received by the Dukes County Manager by August 30,2021. Screened applicants will then be asked to submit full applications for consideration by September 30, 2021.
