

Dear Select Board of Chilmark,

I am writing on behalf of MVNYC Films, Inc, a production company established for the purpose of producing a low-budget independent feature film entitled *Fantasy Life*. The film is a comedic romance set in New York City and Martha's Vineyard about an unemployed Jewish thirtysomething who gets hired to nanny his therapist's granddaughters and ends up falling in love with their unhappily married mother. The second half of the film turns into a family ensemble comedy of errors that takes place in the idyllic setting of Martha's Vineyard and specifically Chilmark.

While we unfortunately do not have the budget to shoot principal photography in Martha's Vineyard, we plan to shoot some B-Roll/2nd Unit photography in multiple areas on the island but focused most intently in Chilmark, where the family portrayed in the film has a home and much of the film's second half takes place.

This crew will be very small—between 5 and 6 of us with just a camera and basic camera accessories, capturing various landscape and textural shots of the area. This will include shots of the harbor, select roads, and at private local businesses who grant written permission to the production. No actors will be involved; the small crew will not make any noise or disturbance to any areas in which we film given the extremely limited amount of gear and footprint we will have.
