Descriptive narrative

The high efficiency heat pump project for Chilmark's school has gone out to bid multiple times over the last few years with the most recent being in March 2023. This brought back a new budget of \$2,442,477 which includes the cost of heat pumps, along with upgrades to ventilation and the overall. The Town and School were looking to sign contracts for the project at the end of April and have installation start at the end of June/early July after the school year ends.
