As requested at the April 20th BOH meeting, here is the State site <https://www.mass.gov/info-details/application-for-municipality-opt-out-of-srmcb-spraying#application-summary-> explaining the terms for an opt-out by the town from mosquito control spraying conducted by the State Reclamation and Mosquito Control Board.

The opt-out application requires that the town: “Host a meeting of the Select Board, at which a vote must be taken indicating the municipality’s intention to opt out of spraying conducted by the SRMCB,” and that the vote to do so be certified and included in the application (see attached Checklist).

I’ve also attached the paperwork with Chilmark’s proposed “alternative mosquito management plan,” which the Board approved at our April 20th meeting.
