The committee met at the town hall at 9:00 on 10/20. Present were Chris Murphy (chair), Hugh Weiseman, Matt Poole, Allison Burger, Ryan Rossi, and Seth Karlinsky.

A brief discussion took place covering 3 main points. 1. The existing building, the engineer's report of its integrity, and our recommendation to the select board that they continue on with Ryan's proposed renovations to make the restrooms as usable as possible for the next few years. Allison agreed to write a letter to the select board explaining our recommendation.

- 2. The existing septic system and its possible condition and the possibility of a de-nitrification component being added. Further discussion was put off until Reid Silva has a chance to evaluate the existing system. Matt will be the contact person with Reid.
- 3. Very brief discussion of long term planning for a replacement structure. It was suggested that perhaps that should be a different committee.

Seth did present some figures for future reference. The current rest room/shower facility uses between 15 and 25,000 gal. of water per season. From 2017 through 2022 the hourly usage was 6 to 10 people and that it was used 24 hours per day.
