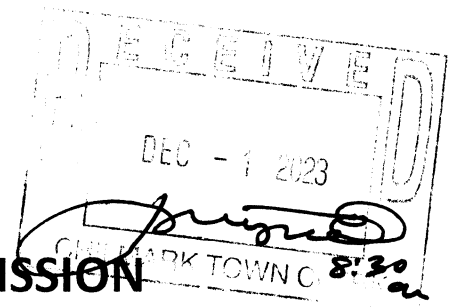


# PUBLIC HEARING MARTHA'S VINEYARD COMMISSION

The public is invited to a public hearing concerning a proposed settlement to resolve pending litigation: *Kim, et al. v. Martha's Vineyard Commission* (C.A. 2274 CV 00042), an appeal of the Commission's denial without prejudice of DRI #718 7 Arlington Avenue, which proposed the demolition of a house built in 1875 and listed in MACRIS and construction of a replacement single-family residence on the property (**DRI #718-S**).
