 Complete the attached Notice of Intent (NOI). The NOI shall be filed with the Issuing Authority on or before: 6/7/2022 Date
for the following:
- Plan to show: utility poles & guy wires, sideline of road, wetlands, edge of vegetation and define the turnoff as well as the proposed areas of maintenance and mowing, including but not limited to the turnoffs, around utility poles, the electric ROW along the eastern edge of the property, any other areas that the applicants wish to mow and maintain regularly.
No further work shall be performed until a public hearing has been held and an Order of Conditions has been issued to regulate said work. The property owner shall take the following action (e.g., erosion/sedimentation controls) to prevent further violations of the Act:
Failure to comply with this Order may constitute grounds for additional legal action. Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40 provides: "Whoever violates any provision of this section (a) shall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than two years, or both, such fine and imprisonment; or (b) shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for each violation". Each day or portion thereof of continuing violation shall constitute a separate offense.
D. Appeals/Signatures
An Enforcement Order issued by a Conservation Commission cannot be appealed to the Department of Environmental Protection, but may be filed in Superior Court.
