Dear Commissioners,

Aquamarine Dock Builders proposes to remove and replace the above mentioned wood frame timber pier with a new pier 3' wide and 33' long (10% increase in square footage).

The existing pier consists of a set of planks set on the ground that leads to the small wood post supported pier. We would replace the whole pier, what is now on the ground and what is currently supported, with 4" X 4" mahogany posts that would be secured to the ground with butterfly brackets and iron pipes, driven in diagonally to prevent settling or lifting.

We would install three sets (six posts) in this manner but the remaining two sets of posts might have to be installed using a jet pump and a small hand held drop hammer. To limit turbidity the pumping would be minimal, just to start the posts in the mud and sand bottom. We would set the posts with the small drop hammer. We propose to surround the whole work area with a turbidity curtain that would confine all the stirred up sediment to the area.

We would launch and deliver to site a small, 4' X 16', work float (launched at the landing across the pond) to load and remove from the site the wood from the existing pier, to deliver material, and to stand on to install the posts in the water because the site is muddy without good footing. We would also frame the pier from the work float.

We would deck the pier with fiberglass decking (70% light penetration) over the vegetated inshore part of the pier, which is about 8' long. We would deck the remainder of the pier with 2" X 8" X 3' treated decking. The frame, also 2" X 8", would be non-leaching, treated, ACQ decking. Any wood in contact with the water would be untreated mahogany. The pier would be bolted together with ½" galvanized bolts.




