Dear Ms. Packer:

The Department of Environmental Protection is in receipt of your Request for a Superseding Order of Conditions dated July 24, 2022.

The Department has reviewed your request and determined that you do not meet the requirements to qualify as an Owner of Land Abutting the Activity as defined in 310 CMR 10.04. The Wetlands Regulations define the Owner of Land Abutting the Activity as the owner of land sharing a common boundary or corner with the site of the proposed activity in any direction. Based on a review of the Chilmark Assessors' Maps, your property does not share a common boundary or corner with the site of the proposed activity.

For this reason, the Department is dismissing your Request for a Superseding Order of Conditions. The Order of Conditions issued by the Chilmark Conservation Commission on July 28, 2022, becomes the final Order for this project.
