I. <u>POSITION TITLE:</u> Traffic Control Supervisor (TSC)

II. <u>SUPERVISOR:</u> Harbormaster (HM)

III. <u>GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES</u>: Assist the HM in regulating and controlling the roadways of Menemsha village, motor vehicle traffic flow and vehicle parking regulations. Supervision and direction of all Harbor Department employees assigned to traffic control and parking responsibilities.

IV. DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Enforce parking regulations within Menemsha Village to include the Menemsha Beach parking area, Basin Road, North Road from the intersection of Basin Road to Boathouse Road, Boathouse Road, and the West Dock parking area.
- B. Maintain law and order on Town wharves, and applicable roadways, and respond to complaints regarding noise, vehicles parked illegally or on private property, traffic flow, traffic obstructions, and other related parking and traffic matters.
- C. Job Schedule: Summer Season

The essential duties listed are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.

These duties shall be performed appropriately to represent the decisions and policies of the Board of Selectmen and with respect and confidentiality for the applicants and the Board.
