The polls were opened at the Chilmark Community Center, at 520 South Road, at 7:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m. Of the one thousand sixty three (1063) registered voters, as of the last day to register to vote on October 24, 2020, in the Town of Chilmark, nine hundred twenty four (924) cast their votes. Seventy three (73) absentee ballots were requested. Six (6) of the absentee ballots requested were issued to non-registered voters who were Specially Qualified/ UOCAVA (Uniformed or Overseas Absentee Voting Act) voters. Of the seventy three (73) absentee ballots requested and issued, sixty six (66) were returned and accepted before the close of polls at 8PM on Nov. 3, 2020. No overseas absentee ballots, postmarked by November 3, 2020, were received via the US mail by 5PM on November 13, 2020 and counted at a meeting of the Board of Registrars after 5PM on Friday, November 13, 2020. No regular absentee ballots, postmarked by November 3, 2020, were received by 5PM on November 6, 2020. Three hundred ninety six (396) applications for a mailed Early Ballot were submitted by the deadline on Wednesday, October 28, 2020 at 5PM. Three hundred thirty four (334) mailed Early Ballots were received by 8PM on November 3, 2020. Two (2) mailed Early Ballots were received by 5PM on November 6, 2020 and the results were amended to add the votes from these two early ballots at a properly posted meeting of the Warden and the Deputy Warden at the Chilmark Town Hall on Saturday, Nov. 7, 2020 at 10AM. Two Hundred Ninety Four (294) voters voted during the in-person Early Voting (EV) period (Oct. 17-30), held at the Chilmark Town Hall. Fifty Six (56) voters, who had submitted an application for a mailed Early Ballot, opted to vote in-person instead at the in-person EV sessions (47) or on the day of the election (9). Four (4) EV voters did not return their EV ballot. There were no provisional ballots voted at either the in-person Early Voting sessions or on the day of the election, Nov. 3, 2020. There were no Federal Write-In Absentee Ballots (FWAB) submitted from a qualified voter for the Nov. 3, 2020 election.
