At 6:30AM on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, the Chilmark Community Center was open to public inspection and Constable Marshall E. Carroll, III opened the ballot box and inspected the interior. After the inspection, the ballot box was closed and locked. At 7:00AM, the polls were opened and the ballot box ballot slot was unlocked.

Of the one thousand one hundred thirty six (1136) registered voters, as of the last day to register to vote on October 29, 2022, in the Town of Chilmark, Seven Hundred Fifty Eight (758) voters cast their ballots.

A total of thirty-one (31) Absentee Ballot applications were submitted. Of these thirty-one (31) applications, six (6) were submitted by UOCAVA (Uniformed or Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act) voters for electronic ballots and eighteen (18) were submitted for domestically mailed (USPS) ballots, by the deadline of Tuesday, Nov. 1, 2022, at 5PM. Seven (7) Absentee Ballot In-Person applications were submitted before the Nov. 7, 2022, 12PM deadline. Twenty-nine (29) Absentee Ballots were returned and accepted by 8PM on Election Day. One (1) Absentee Ballot was received on Friday, Nov. 12, 2022 before 5PM, with a postmark of Nov. 8, 2022, accepted and the unofficial results were amended, to add the votes from this one (1) absentee ballot, at a properly posted meeting of the Warden and the Deputy Warden at the Chilmark Town Hall on Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2022 at 9AM. One (1) Absentee Ballot, returned in the mail due to an incorrect mailing address provided by voter, was rejected.

By the deadline of Tuesday, Nov. 1, 2022 at 5PM, two hundred forty eight (248) voters submitted an application for an Early Vote By Mail Ballot. Two hundred forty eight (248) ballots were mailed to voters. A total of one hundred eighty eight (188) Vote By Mail ballots were returned and accepted. Five Vote By Mail Ballots were received on Friday, Nov. 12, 2022 before 5PM, with a postmark of Nov. 8, 2022 or earlier, accepted and the unofficial results were amended, to add the votes from these five (5) early Vote By Mail ballots, at a properly posted meeting of the Warden and the Deputy Warden at the Chilmark Town Hall on Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2022 at 9AM. Nineteen (19) voters, who had applied to Vote By Mail, chose to vote in person on Nov. 8, 2022. Eight (8) voters, who had applied to Vote By Mail, chose to vote in person during the In-Person Early Voting sessions held at Chilmark Town Hall between Sat., Oct. 22, 2022 and Fri., Nov. 4, 2022. Eleven (11) Vote By Mail ballots were rejected due to no signature on the affidavit (EV7) envelope. Two (2) Vote By Mail ballots were rejected due to an incorrect mailing address provided by voter.

During the In-Person Early Voting sessions held at Chilmark Town Hall between Sat., Oct. 22, 2022 and Fri., Nov. 4, 2022. Eighty-seven (87) voters voted early.

No *mailed* UOCAVA (Uniformed or Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act) absentee ballots, postmarked by November 8, 2022, were received via the USPS mail by 5PM on November 18, 2022.

Twenty-six (26) early Vote By Mail voters did not return their ballot. Two (2) provisional ballots were requested, applied for and voted on the day of the election, Nov. 8, 2022. After investigation, neither of the provisional voters were found to be eligible. There were no Federal Write-In Absentee Ballots (FWABs) submitted from a qualified voter for the Nov. 8, 2022 election.


