- Requests to remain on the Slip Waiting list or Mooring Waiting list must be received by the Harbormaster by 5:00 p.m. EST to remain on either list.

November 1

• Moorings must be removed from ponds to permit shell fishing.

November 15

- Harbormaster will send Slip and Mooring Contracts to Slip Holders and Mooring Permit Holders from the prior year to be completed and returned.
