I was not able to find the source of the land that the Commonwealth gave to the Town of either Gay Head or Chilmark. I checked the Indian Maps in the Registry of Probate and was not able to see this land marked on any of the Commissioner's maps on file there. As you can see from my grantee search, I could not find any taking by or deed to the Commonwealth or the Massachusetts Bay Colon y of this piece. My best advice toward a further search would be to go to the Land Court and read Case No. 7706.
