We strongly support continued access for the homeowners at Squibnocket because it is a town approved subdivision. A safe durable and modest roadway, (not comprised of two lanes) is necessary. We think it would be wise to separate the beach parking lot from the Squibnocket resident's access road. The board supports investigating the possibility of obtaining the Peter Weldon lot to be utilized as beach parking. The board is in favor of obtaining more beach on either side of what is currently leased and is strongly in favor of removing the current stone revetment. Special care should be given to removing what is still remaining of the former wooden bulkhead and the large stones that were part of the former bulkhead. (Currently in water and an impediment to safe swimming) We'd also like to investigate the restoration of the old herring run and support the possibility of the flushing of sea water into Squibnocket pond for the potential revitalization of fisheries.
